

THE COMPANY PRESENTED AT CHINA'S NITROGEN & PHOSPHORUS REDUCTION CONFERENCE IN BEIJING

June 8, 2011 – Vancouver, Canada. Alpha Wastewater, Inc. was invited to present at China's Nitrogen & Phosphorus Reduction Technology Conference held on June 7 and 8, 2011 in Beijing. The presentation was on Alpha's USBF® wastewater treatment technology.

Alpha was represented by Justin Wang, Vice President International Development, Zhijun Gao of Alpha Beijing Wastewater, and technical representative Justin Hebner of ECOfluid Systems, Inc.

The audience consisted of over 100 industry experts, university professors and government officials, looking to build and/or improve their critical municipal wastewater treatment systems. Alpha's objective was to introduce the USBF technology to this select audience, and to be included in the Recommended Technology List approved by the Wastewater Ministry.

China's Central Government has allocated US\$1B for improving infrastructure in its villages, and having the USBF technology included on this Recommended Technology List would enhance the ability to get wastewater treatment projects approved under this significant funding program.
