



THE COMPANY SIGNS ITS FIRST TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR THE USBF® WASTEWATER TREATMENT TECHNOLOGY

June 14, 2011 – Vancouver, Canada. Alpha Wastewater, Inc. has signed its first Technology Transfer License Agreement for its award-winning USBF® wastewater treatment technology. The agreement is with ECOfluid Systems, Inc., a Vancouver-based company, for the defined territory of North America, Central America and the Caribbean.

ECOfluid Systems, Inc. already has many operating plants in this territory, and will retain the right to build new plants in the territory for which Alpha will receive a specified percentage of the sales fee.

Alpha and ECOfluid will continue to work cooperatively to enable both companies to better develop their opportunities to build more USBF® technology plants.

Alpha will develop its own plants in other regions, focusing initially in China and India, and will search for qualified licensees for exclusive territorial rights in other countries throughout the world.

Note: Alpha Wastewater is the current operating name of the company, which is registered in the State of Nevada as Silicon South, Inc. (OTCBB – SSOU). The company has filed a preliminary 14C information statement with the US Securities and Exchange Commission to change its name to Alpha Wastewater, Inc. and expects the name change to be completed soon. The company's head office is located in Vancouver, BC, Canada, with a branch consulting office in Beijing, China.
